Dear Resident of New Berlin City and its Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (ETJ),

Hope this letter finds you all doing well. As a resident of the New Berlin community, you enjoy a country atmosphere with neighbors who are willing to help each other. We have rich traditions such as our Volunteer Fire Department's annual fund-raising events, and integral groups like the Community Club.

You may not know this, but New Berlin is the only city in Guadalupe County without a mandated local property tax to help fund city expenses. Instead, our city only asks for a voluntary donation of \$100 per year per residence to help cover city expenses. Not everyone participates so the City Council must and does use moneys from this voluntary donation and local sales tax revenues very frugally. However, the costs to maintain roads and other large item expenses fall strictly on the city's budget. Guadalupe County currently does not give our city any money for roadways in our area that are not part of the state highway system such as FM 775. Even though property owners pay a county road tax, the city receives none of that money.

Please note that due to changes in personnel staff at New Berlin City Hall the 2022 tax donation letter was not sent out. We apologize for any confusion this may have caused. If you would like to include your 2022 tax donation along with your 2023 tax donation, please feel free to do so. Thank you to those who voluntarily brought in their 2022 tax donations last year.
