ORDINANCE NO. <u>04-001</u>

STREET CLOSURE ORDINANCE FOR OLD SCHOOL ROAD

Section 1. Purpose of Ordinance.

The purpose of this Ordinance shall be to close Old School Road between Brietzke Road and FM 775 during the New Berlin Sausage Festival in an effort to protect the citizens and visitors of the City of New Berlin during the annual Sausage Festival hosted by the New Berlin Community Club and the New Berlin Volunteer Fire Department.

Section 2. General Prohibition.

The street "Old School Road" within the City of New Berlin shall be closed to thru traffic beginning at 8:00 a.m. on the Saturday proceeding Labor Day in any year and shall remain closed until 12:00 noon on Labor Day that year.

Section 3. Exceptions.

The only vehicular traffic allowed on Old School Road during the period of closure shall be that of the residents and businesses on Old School Road, any emergency response vehicle, and any person acting on behalf of the New Berlin Sausage Festival.

Section 4. Notice to Residents or Businesses.

All persons whose houses or businesses front the street being closed and owners of those driveways that access Old School Road shall be notified in writing that the street will be closed. Said notice shall be sent by U.S. Mail or delivered in person by the City Secretary or any Alderman at least 30 days prior to the closing of the street.

Section 5. Barricades.

Barricades which comply with the Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices shall be placed on Old School Road at the intersection of Brietzke Road and at the intersection of FM 775.

Section 6. Severability.

If any action, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provisions and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 7. Remedies.

Violators of this ordinance shall be issued a citation and upon conviction for such violation shall be punished by a penalty of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200).

Section 8. Effective Date.

The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval, and publication.
